



NEAIRA


NEAIRA is a British and a British-born female singer called Neaira and called to be a star.



Strokes

A stroke is a sudden interruption in the blood supply to part of the brain. This can be caused by a blood clot blocking a blood vessel, or by a blood vessel in the brain bursting and bleeding into the brain.



Risk factors: High blood pressure, Diabetes, High cholesterol, Smoking, Alcohol, Obesity, Atrial fibrillation, Heart disease, Stroke family history, Age, Race, Sex, Previous stroke.

Signs and symptoms: Sudden weakness or numbness in face, arm or leg, Sudden confusion, Sudden trouble seeing, Sudden trouble speaking, Sudden trouble hearing, Sudden trouble walking or being balanced.

How to treat a stroke: Treatments are usually treated with different types of medication. These include aspirin, statins, blood thinners, and surgery. Aspirin may help to prevent a stroke by making the blood less sticky.







Pythagoras' Theorem

- Only works for right angled triangles
- Uses two sides to find a third side
- Basic formula is $a^2 + b^2 = c^2$



$$a^2 + b^2 = c^2$$


$$BC^2 + 3^2 = 6^2$$

$$BC^2 = 6^2 - 3^2 = 36 - 9 = 27$$

$$BC = \sqrt{27} = 3\sqrt{3}$$



THE NATURE OF EUTHANASIA: DEFINITIONS

Euthanasia (Greek origins of word)- 'good death'

Voluntary euthanasia/ assisted suicide: when a person wants help to end their life due to a terrible illness or incredible pain.

Active euthanasia: the act of ending a life intentionally, perhaps by giving a strong dose of painkillers. This is illegal in the UK and most countries in the world.



CHRISTIAN ATTITUDE 1: EUTHANASIA IS MURDER

- This is the view of the Catholic Church and conservative Christians e.g. Evangelicals
- Life is created by God and is **sacred** (the idea of the **divinity of human life**). Humans are made in the **image of God** (the imago dei): "So God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them." Genesis 1:27. Life is precious to God, who gave it to us.
- It is God who decides when life is given and when it is taken. Job 1:21: 'The LORD gave and the LORD has taken away'. Therefore life is not down to human choice.
- The 10 commandments include: 'Thou shalt not murder' (Exodus 20:13) and active euthanasia is considered by
