## Vocational study programmes

- Sixth form/Further Education College
- Apprenticeship with an employer
- Traineeship with a college/training provider/employer
- Employment with training/learning

## **Apprenticeships**

This is a combination of on-the job and off-the-job training. Courses usually last 2 years, during which you will work 4 days and attend college or another training provider for one day a week.

There are 4 different apprenticeship levels:

- intermediate: level 2
- advanced: level 3
- higher: level 4 or 5
- degree: level 6 or 7



## **T** Levels

T Levels are new courses that are equivalent to 3 A Levels. T Levels are usually 2 year courses and offer students a mixture of classroom learning and 'on the-job' experience during an industry placement of around three months.

## **Traineeships**

Traineeships involve a programme of up to six to twelve months of study, including a work placement which will prepare you for an apprenticeship or employment.
